A Word From Tony

Rev Daniel Bullock - DoMM

During our service today we will be hearing from Rev Daniel Bullock who is the Director of Mission & Ministries (DoMM) at the Baptist Union of Victoria (BUV), a position he took up in February 2012.

Before commencing at the Baptist Union of Victoria, Daniel was the Senior Pastor at Essendon Baptist Community Church, a position he held from August 2007 to February 2012. Daniel also worked at NewHope Baptist Church for 11 years as the Senior Associate Pastor where he served in a number of roles, overseeing a large staff team and diverse ministries. Prior to NewHope, Daniel served as the Interim Pastor at Berwick Community Baptist Church. His key strengths are in the areas of strategy and staff development, preaching, teaching and coaching emerging leaders.

Daniel commenced his working life as an electrical linesman for the Heidelberg City Council Electricity Supply and then the State Electricity Commission. He worked as a linesman for 11 years before responding to God's call on his life to pastoral ministry and ordination.

At the age of 26 Daniel had a transformational encounter with God which eventually led him to study a Bachelor of Ministry at the Bible College of Victoria, followed by the process of ordination training at Whitely College, and ultimately into his calling as a local church pastor. Daniel was ordained in 2000 and subsequently completed a Master of Arts in Church Leadership at the Australian College of Ministry in 2007. He is married to Derynne and they have a teenage son, Matthew.

With the authority invested to this position by Union Council, the Director of Mission and Ministries (DoMM) is responsible for the development and leadership of the vision and mission of the Baptist Denomination in Victoria. With the vision to 'Advance the Kingdom of God by empowering church leaders for mission', the DoMM's role is to champion the message and the strategies developed to progress this vision. Daniel also oversees all the staff employed at the BUV office hub.



BUV Advice on Coronavirus (COVID-19) – Places of Worship

From 11:59pm on 21 June, places of worship can open for private worship or small religious ceremonies for up to 50 people in each separate space. Groups can be no larger than 20 people and be divided into separate areas.

In clarification; the BUV has been advised that from Monday 22 June: if you have a building that has completely separate areas - you can have 50 in each area- BUT within those separate areas you have to split into groups no larger than 20. Over this, the social distancing (1.5m social distancing and 4sqm rule) apply. DHHS cannot clarify how far apart each group of 20 needs to be from each other. It is anticipated this information will be available by June 21 when the restrictions begin. Adherence is required to: social distancing, sanitising, hygiene requirements, cleaning afterwards, contact tracing etc.

FTG Church Moving Forward Within Restrictions

We are awaiting further clarification, especially with regard to 'Private Worship'. However, taking all restrictions into account, we would like to move ahead with some aspects of FTG Church life. Below are some dates and events for you to note.

Wednesday 24th June – Prayer Focus time at the Church at 10am and 7.30pm through ZOOM. Please call or text Pastor Tony if you intend coming to the 10am time at the Church or want to be involved in the Zoom meeting at 7.30pm.

Wednesday 1st July – German speaking service at the Church at 10am. Please advise Helmut Becker if you intend on coming.

Sunday 5th July – Church Life Meeting at the Church at 2pm. The main agenda item will be to discuss and vote on work to be carried out on the ceiling in the main auditorium. 2 Quotes have been received to carry out works. Costs are in the vicinity of \$14,000.

Saturday 11th July – Working Bee at the Church starting at 8.30am to do a general tidy up. BYO food and drink.

Monday 13th July – Possible return of playgroup at the Church. Further guidelines and procedures are being sought from the from the BUV and Children's Playgroup Network.

Sunday 19th July – Church Home Luncheons. We are encouraging that you to take the opportunity of inviting 1 or 2 family units to your home for lunch especially on this Sunday. A Family unit could be 1 or more people.
