I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. Romans 12:1-2

A Word From Tony

A Practical Doctrine

As we return to the book of Romans, it important to note that Paul has moved from **doctrine** in chapters 1-11 to **practice** (application) in chapters 12-16.

F.F.Bruce writes: 'Doctrine is never taught in the Bible simply that it may be known, it is taught in order that it may be translated into practice: "*if you know these things, blessed are you if you do them*" (John 13:17). Hence Paul repeatedly follows up an exposure of doctrine with an ethical exhortation, the latter being linked to the former, as here, with the particle 'therefore' (cf - Ephesians 4:1, Colossians 3:5).'

So, as we turn to Romans 12, in view of all that God has accomplished for believers in Christ, the question can be asked, how should believers live? Paul says that they should present themselves to God as a 'living sacrifice', consecrated to Him. However, we need to note, the animal sacrifices of an earlier day have been rendered forever obsolete by Christ's self-offering. However, there is always room for the worship rendered by obedient hearts. Instead of living by the standards of a world, which is at discord with God, believers are exhorted to let the renewing of their minds by the power of the Spirit transform their/our lives into conformity with God's will.




