



Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them. Romans 12:6a



A Word From Tony

Using Gifts Provided

As we turn to Romans 12:3-8, we find Paul talking about the metaphor of the body to describe the first purpose of every Christian. He is showing what it looks like to sacrifice our bodies and minds in service to God as a response to His great mercy to us.

All Christians together are meant to operate as a single human body. Since we are all in Christ, by definition, we are Christ's body on earth. We are to function in the world as a single entity. That does not mean, however, that God intends for each of us to be exactly the same. We are not robotic. We serve wildly different functions just as all the different parts of a human body serve different functions. Our job is to serve our function, in service to God and each other, in the power of God.

And Paul makes the point, God provides power to all believers to undertake that task. Paul talks of Spiritual gifts, referred to in verse 6 as "gifts according to grace", and in verse 3, "a measure of faith." And we need to understand that Spiritual gifts should be understood to be different than talents or abilities, as the list of gifts Paul provides in Romans 12-6-8 makes it clear. Three other lists of Spiritual gifts are found in the New Testament in 1 Corinthians 12:8–10, 28–30; 1 Peter 4:11; Ephesians 4:11.

But it is important to notice that God intends for us not just to have these gifts of grace but to actually use them. He begins by saying those with the gift of prophecy should use it in proportion with their faith. In other words, proclaiming a prophecy from God to the other members of the church is an action that requires faith that the message has been given by God.

Pastoral Search Process

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I want to give you an update of how we are going with the Pastor Search process. The Covid pandemic has not made it easy, but despite that, we have been in contact with the Baptist Union and informed them of our need for a new Pastor from the 28th November 2021 onwards.

Our contact person at the BUV is Robert Hayman who was the guest speaker on Sunday 15th August and gave a good message. We have been in contact him a number of times. Also, during his recent leave, we have also been in contact with Jonathan Stark, Head of Pastoral Leadership Support & Development for the BUV. The BUV have indicated that they will support us through this period.

Jonathan and Robert have also assured us that the BUV can provide an Interim Pastor until the time when the new Pastor can start. Jonathan said that they will let us know very soon who it could possibly be. The Church, has the final say on any proposed interim.

Apart from that, the BUV will also provide a Moderator to help us with the pastor search meetings. These meetings will have to be done on ZOOM for the time being. Robert Hayman has indicated that it is not advisable for the Pastor Search committee to meet without a Moderator so we will have to wait until we know who it will be.

In the meantime, let us continue to pray that Lord God will guide us all the way and that He will provide for us a Pastor of His choice.
