The Wise Men Who Missed It

Matthew 2:1-6

A. Christmas is Past

- 1. Past in our experience this year.
- 2. Past in the scene before us in the Bible.

B. We Are All Familiar with the Wise Men

- 1. They came from the East, following the star, bringing their gifts.
- 2. Going first to Jerusalem and called before King Herod.

C. The Mystery Of The Wise Men And Their Mission

- 1. We don't know exactly where they came from (Babylon?) or how many came.
- 2. We don't know exactly when they arrived—maybe up to two years later (2:16).
- 3. We don't know how they knew the star signalled the birth of Christ.

D. Some Things We Do Know

- 1. They were wise men, and wise men still seek the Saviour.
- 2. Those who truly seek Him find Him (Jeremiah 29:13).
- 3. The wise men didn't arrive at the stable, as often portrayed.
- 4. They found Jesus in a house (Matthew 2:11).

E. But There Is a Group of Wise Men Who Did Not Go to Bethlehem

- 1. Herod called the priests and scribes to advise him about the birth of the King.
- 2. They knew the location was "In Bethlehem of Judea" (v. 5).
- 3. They did not believe the Lord had come and thereby missed the incarnation.
- 4. They doubted Christ's deity all their lives.
- 5. They would be thorns in His side, and help place thorns on His brow.
- 6. Many today have similar attitudes toward Jesus.
- 7. Some see Jesus as a good man, a great teacher, or a prophet.
- 8. But stop short of salvation (Acts 16:31).

F. They Knew the Scriptures But Did Not Find the Saviour (v. 6)

- 1. They immediately went to Scripture to answer Herod's question.
- 2. They were acquainted with Micah 5:2 but didn't apply it.
- 3. Knowing the Bible alone doesn't save; you must find and follow the Saviour.

G. They Knew Christ Would Rule But Would Not Let Him Rule Them (v. 6)

- 1. v6 mentions a Governor to rule Israel.
- 2. Prophecy was unfolding before them, but they didn't act.
- 3. Some today see prophecy fulfilled but don't respond.

H. Why Didn't These Other Wise Men Hurry to Bethlehem?

- 1. They may have feared losing favour with Herod.
- 2. They may have quickly fallen back into routines.
- 3. They may have thought the risk too great if the rumour was false.

I. Some Wise Men Risk Everything to Find the Saviour

- 1. The Wise Men travelled far to find Jesus, devoting time and effort.
- 2. They worshipped Him and presented gifts of
 - a. gold (royalty),
 - b. frankincense (priestly work),
 - c. myrrh (suffering).

J. God Warns and Directs

- 1. The Wise Men were warned in a dream to avoid Herod.
- 2. Joseph was warned to flee to Egypt with Jesus.
- 3. God's warnings direct us to His purposes.

K. Have You Experienced a Warning from God?

- 1. Consider if changes are needed in your life to align with His will.
- 2. Are you willing to let Him change your life's direction?
